Employees Paddle With A Purpose

Saco, ME- June 19, 2019— On Saturday, June 1st, a team of Maine Water and Connecticut Water employees paddled along the Kennebec River in the annual Paddle for Pine Tree Camp fundraiser that helps Maine kids and adults with disabilities attend summer camp. More than \$3,500 was raised by the team.



All proceeds directly support the campership fund, and are a critical part of the camp's open door tuition policy. Since 1945, Pine Tree Camp has welcomed all who could benefit, regardless of their ability to pay. Ninety-nine percent of campers cannot afford to pay the tuition and the paddle is a major fundraiser to ensure they can attend. The camp provides an innovative barrier-free environment offering fully accessible recreation to Maine children and adults with physical and/or developmental disabilities.
